

Trade Days of Waxahachie Texas - Vendor Rules

Payment and Terms

1. Payment for the market weekend is due in advance. Booth spaces will not be assigned without payment.
2. Personal Checks, Cashier Checks, Money Orders, Cash and Credit Cards are acceptable forms of payment. Return check fees apply.
3. There will be no refunds. In case of an emergency, approval may be granted to rollover a paid booth fee to the next market weekend. TD management must be notified as soon as possible before the scheduled market weekend. Failure to notify will be considered NO SHOW and fees will be forfeited.
4. Anyone selling, swapping, trading, or otherwise engaging in business must have a valid receipt issued by TD management.
5. To reserve the same booth space for the next market, advance payment is required. Booth spaces left un-renewed are considered available to lease the Friday after market weekend.

Vendor Setup and Breakdown Requirements

1. Advertised Operating Hours - Saturday 9:00am - 5:00pm
Sunday 9:00am - 4:00pm
Vendor Setup Times - Friday 3:00pm - 9:00pm
Saturday 7:00am - 9:00am
2. Vehicles must be removed from building 30 minutes prior to advertised opening hours. No vehicles will be allowed inside the building before advertised closing hours.
3. Vendors are required to keep booth spaces open until the advertised closing time. Vendors experiencing emergency situations that require setup or break down outside of the scheduled times must notify TD Management. Management will determine the nearest exit which causes the least amount of Disruption to the marketplace, merchandise and display must be hand carried out of the building.
4. Vendors requiring electrical service are responsible for supplying their own extension cords. All extension cords must be heavy duty and securely taped to floors so as not to pose a safety hazard to other vendors and market customers. (No electric heaters or air conditioners allowed)
5. Vendors assume responsibility for manning their booth during advertised market hours.
6. Each vendor will sell and display only in the booth space leased.
7. All advertisements must be displayed within the confines of the booth space. No advertisement may be placed on buildings, trees, posts, fences or any other property around the marketplace without prior approval of TD management.

General Policy and Information

1. Discrimination based on Race, Ethnicity, National Origin, Ancestry, Sexual Orientation, Gender, Age, Political affiliation, or Religious belief is prohibited.
2. Vendors are responsible for sales tax and all licenses required.
3. Vendors are responsible for keeping their booth spaces clean. Trash receptacles are provided throughout the marketplace. Large trash dump bins are located on the east and west side of the marketplace for your convenience.
4. Trade Days is not responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen personal property or damage to vehicles while on the market grounds.
5. The public consumption, selling, dispensing, or donating of alcoholic beverages of any kind is not permitted on the market grounds.
6. Loud music and other loud noises that Trade Days management deems inappropriate will not be allowed.
7. Parents or guardians are responsible for minor children brought onto the premises. Bicycles, skates, skateboards, scooters are not permitted on market grounds.
8. No motorized conveyances allowed except for disabled participants with single person conveyances.
9. Only service pets will be allowed in or near booth spaces selling food items. Vendors bringing pets to the marketplace must abide by the following rules.
 - A. Pets must be kept on a leash or in a pet carrier at all times.
 - B. Pets must be confined within the booth or outside market building.
 - C. Pets must not be left unattended inside the market building.
 - D. Do not walk pets in the grassy areas surrounding market building front or side entrances.
 - E. It is reasonable to anticipate accidents, in that case owners are responsible for proper cleanup, removal and disposal of the pets' waste products
 - F. Trade Days management reserves the right to request the removal of pets at anytime during market weekend.
10. Trade Days reserves the right to refuse admission to any vendor and limit or restrict merchandise selection being offered by vendor.
